At Godrej Agrovet Limited (GAVL), we value environmental resources and are embedding sustainability into processes and value chains across our businesses. To that end, we are working to reduce hazardous and non-hazardous, liquid and solid waste generation at our sites, increasing recycling and reuse of waste, and aiming to achieve Zero Waste to Landfill status by 2020.

In line with our sustainability vision, we are committed to the following actions:

- Conserving natural resources, and minimizing the volume and possible environmental harm of the waste we generate and dispose across our supply chain
- Ensuring the safe and secure handling, organisation, and transportation of our raw materials, packaging materials and finished products.
- Adhering to all applicable waste management laws
- Incorporating life cycle thinking at the design stage to eliminate waste generation throughout the product or process life cycle
- Following waste management hierarchy – Avoidance, Reuse, Recycling, Energy recovery, and Treatment & Disposal.
- Training our team members on all aspects of waste management relevant to their roles. We also strive to educate our suppliers and business partners, customers and stakeholders regarding the responsible handling and use of our products.

The policy applies to all GAVL business units, the entities we own, and the entities in which we own a majority interest, and the actions of any associated employees.

Oversight

The Managing Director supported by the Head - Manufacturing & Supply Chain Excellence, oversees our waste management commitments in consultation with business heads and manufacturing unit heads. The Executive Committee provides Board level oversight.
